Status of Your Economic Impact Payment

Do you want to check on the status of your economic impact payment? The IRS has created an online tool to track payments.

If you filed a 2018 or 2019 tax return, and authorized the IRS to make a direct deposit of your refund that you were due, then payments will be made directly to your bank account. People with the lowest incomes are expected to start reviewing their payment on April 15, 2020. For individuals, the amount will be \$1,200, if your adjusted gross income was \$75,000 or less. You cannot receive a payment if you are counted as a dependent on someone else's tax return.

The IRS has established an online tool called, "Get My Payment," that can be used to check on the status of your money.

Action Steps

- Visit the IRS online tool called: "Get My Payment." <u>irs.gov/coronavirus/get-my-payment</u>
- 2. You will need to enter some key information about yourself: your Social Security number, date of birth and mailing address.
- 3. Due to the demand by so many people trying to access the site, it may take more than one try to open the link. Be patient and keep trying.
