The American Dream Employment Network (ADEN) is an administrative Employment Network (EN) – a consortium of service providers and employers working together to create a path for individuals with disabilities, who are currently receiving Social Security disability benefits, and want to return to, or begin working for the first time. ADEN provides technical assistance and training to employment service providers, such as American Job Centers, Employers, Community Rehabilitation Providers and other interested Community Partners, from across the country, who provide high quality employment services to Social Security disability beneficiaries.
