

Diana Perkins – Co-founder and CEO of includesign



Diana Perkins is the cofounder and CEO of includesign, a product design firm creating products that empower individuals with disabilities. She has degrees in Mechanical Engineering and Industrial Design from Brown University, and she turned her senior capstone project into includesign's first product, the LapSnap. The LapSnap is a collapsible carryall designed with and for wheelchair users to help increase independence by enabling them to carry items hands free. To learn more, check out TheLapSnap.com.

Adam David Jones – CEO and Founder of Zeer



Adam David Jones is the CEO of The One and Only Corporation and the creator of Zeer. Zeer is 21st-century personal safety software that runs on smartphones and responds to emergencies with machine learning, creating an autonomous safety response system with connected devices. Six years ago, Adam was violently assaulted. After a coma and lengthy recovery, his attacker was acquitted by a jury. He now dedicates his life to preventing this from happening to someone else.

Ola Ojewumi – Activist/Entrepreneur/ Public Speaker



Ola Ojewumi is a writer and disability rights activist, and the founder of Sacred Hearts Children's Transplant Foundation, and Project ASCEND. Ola initiated these charitable efforts after receiving a life-saving heart and kidney transplant and surviving cancer. Her organizations have awarded thousands of dollars in college scholarships to disabled students, funding for women's education programs, support for global mentorship groups and literacy programs, and distributes teddy bears and books to children awaiting organ transplants.

She also created Ola's Truth Boutique, a disability pride apparel company. The Boutique is transforming the image of disability into something to take pride in and not shame.
