## TYPES OF iPADS

## BUTTONS

### VOLUME BUTTONS

Use to adjust the volume when listening to music, watching videos, or playing games

### TOP BUTTON

Press to wake your device or put it to sleep. Press and hold the top button to turn your device off or on

### HOME BUTTON

If your device has a home button, it will be located on the front screen. It can unlock the iPad or take you to the Home screen

## BATTERY & WIFI INFORMATION

### BATTERY & WIFI LOCATION

Located at the top of the screen



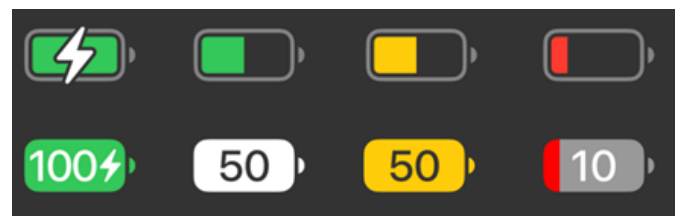
### WIFI STRENGTH

The more bars the stronger the signal



### BATTERY LIFE

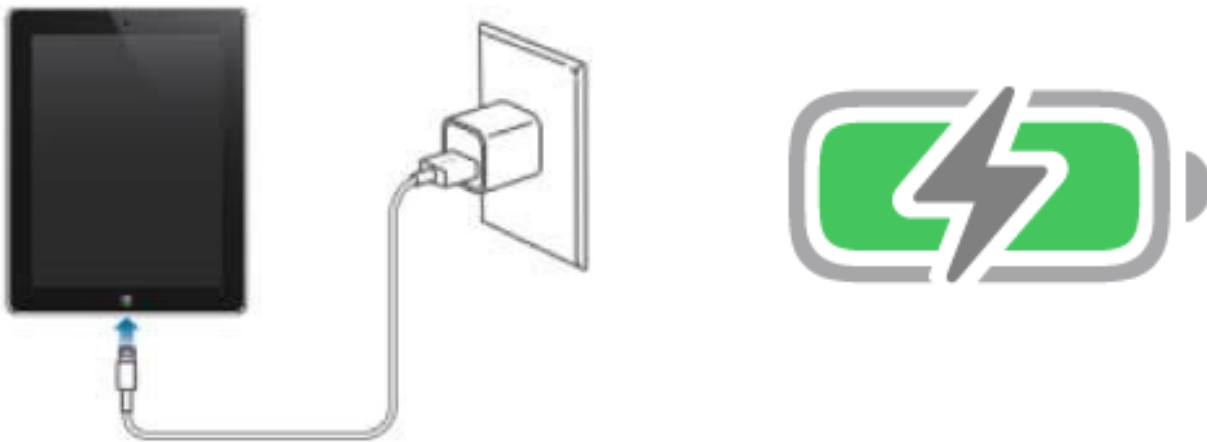
The fuller the battery icon or the higher the number, the longer the battery should last



## CHARGING AN IPAD BATTERY

Check the border of the iPad to locate the port. Plug the iPad's charger into the port and to its included adapter. Then plug the adapter into a wall outlet.

When an iPad is charging a lightning bolt will appear in the battery icon. If the volume is turned on, then there will be a small chime when you plug in the charger.
